

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(KIDMORE END) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82 and 84 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Kidmore End (Speed Limits) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**.
2. No persons shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
3. The roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order shall be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
4. No persons shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
6. The Oxfordshire County Council (Restricted Roads) (Kidmore End Parish) Order 1999 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

20mph speed limit

<i>Butlers Orchard</i>	<i>in its entirety</i>	
<i>Chalkhouse Green Road</i>	<i>from its junction with Kidmore Lane, south-eastwards</i>	<i>for a distance of 455 metres.</i>
<i>Craysleaze</i>	<i>in its entirety</i>	
<i>Coopers Pightle</i>	<i>in its entirety</i>	
<i>Tokers Green Lane</i>	<i>from its junction with Wood Lane, southwards</i>	<i>to a point 75 metres south of its junction with Butlers Orchard.</i>
<i>Wood Lane</i>	<i>from its junction with Kidmore Lane, north-westwards</i>	<i>for 390 metres</i>

SCHEDULE 2

30mph speed limit

- a) ~~Butlers Orchard~~ in its entirety
- b) Chalkhouse Green Road from its junction with Kidmore End Road, northwards for a distance of ~~325~~ 330 metres
- c) ~~Chalkhouse Green Road~~ from its junction with Kidmore Lane to a point 23 metres south of the property known as Kees
- d) Dysonwood Lane from its junctions with Tokers Green Lane, east for a distance of 330 metres.
- e) Gaskells End in its entirety
- f) Hazelmoor Lane from its junction with Horsepond Road, to its junction with Kidmore Lane.
- g) Horsepond Road from a point 22 metres northeast of its junction with Woodside Lane, to a point 27 metres southwest of its junction with Wood Lane.
- h) Kidmore End Road from its junction with Chalkhouse Green Road southwards for 145 metres.
- i) Kidmore Lane from its junction with ~~Wood Lane~~ Hazelmoor Lane, north-eastwards to its junction with Reades Lane at Sonning Common.
- j) Orchard Field in its entirety.
- k) Reades Lane from its junction with Horsepond Road, to a point 185 metres west of its junction with Ashford Avenue, Sonning Common.
- l) Rokeby Drive from its junction with Tokers Green Lane westwards to its junction with A4074, partly in the Parish of Mapledurham.
- m) Tanners Lane from its junction with Chalkhouse Green Road, south and eastwards to its junction with Kidmore End Road.
- n) The Hamlet in its entirety.
- p) ~~Tokers Green Lane~~ from its junction with Wood Lane, to a point 75 metres south of its junction with Butlers Orchard.

- o) Tokers Green Lane from a point 148 metres north of its junction with Kidmore Road Reading, to a point 640 495 metres north of its junction with Rokeby Drive Skarries View.
- p) Wood Lane from its junction with Horsepond Road to a point 390 metres northwest of its junction with Kidmore Lane.
