The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of their powers under sections 82(2) and 83(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Restricted Roads) (Kidmore End Parish) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 20 December 1999.
2. The roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
3. The Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads, Gallowstree Common, Kidmore End) (40mph. Speed Limit) Order 1992, by virtue of which a speed limit of 40 miles per hour was imposed on the roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order, is hereby revoked.

from its junction with Chalkhouse Green Road, south and east to its junction with Kidmore End Road.

o) The Hamlet

in its entirety.

p) Tokers Green Lane

from its junction with Wood Lane, to a point 75 metres south of its junction with Butlers Orchard.

q) Tokers Green Lane

from a point 148 metres north of its junction with Kidmore Road Reading, to a point 640 metres north of its junction with Rokeby Drive.

r) Wood Lane

from its junction with Horsepond Road to its junction with Kidmore Lane.

SCHEDULE 2

a) Horsepond Road

from a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Wood Land to a point 15 metres north-east of the track leading to Rose Cottage, a distance of approximately 850 metres.

b) Wood Lane

from its junction with Horsepond Road for a distance of 260 metres south-eastwards.

c) Un-named Lane leading to Common Lane

leading from its junction with Horsepond Road for a distance of 10 metres north-westwards.

d) Hazelmoor Lane

from its junction with Horsepond Road for a distance of 200 metres south-eastwards.

e) Reades Lane

from its junction with Horsepond Road for a distance of 120 metres south-eastwards.

f) The Hamlet

its entire length between its south-western and north-eastern junctions of Horsepond Road, a distance of approximately 430 metres.
