Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015

The Council's annual return needs to be reviewed by an external auditor appointed by Public Sector Audit Appointments Ltd. Any person interested has the right to inspect the accounting records for the financial year to which the audit relates and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts and documents relating to those records or documents.

These documents for Kidmore End Parish Council are to be made available, on reasonable notice, between 5 June and 14 July 2017 inclusive. If you wish to view them, please contact the Clerk of the Council at the address below, or by telephone on 0118 947 3130.

Local electors and their representatives have rights to question the auditor about the accounts or object to the accounts or any item in them. Written notice of an objection must first be given to the auditor and a copy sent to the Council. The auditor can be contacted at the address below during the inspection period, which commences on 5 June and ends on 14 July 2017.

The Council's annual return is subject to review by the appointed auditor under the provisions of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014, the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015 and the National Audit Office's Code of Audit Practice.
