

KIDMORE END PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of a special meeting of the Parish Council held at the Kidmore End Church of England (Aided) School, Kidmore End on Thursday 1 July 2021 at 7.30pm and concluded at 8.10pm.

Present: T M Perchard (Vice-Chairman, in the Chair), J M Ducker, A P Harland, Ms S Matthews.

Apologies for absence were received from A Whyles.

It was reported that, on advice from the Monitoring Officer of the District Council, the Chairman of the Council and Mr I G C Pearson would not take part in consideration of the Kidmore End Neighbourhood Development Plan by the Council, because of the risk of bias, or the appearance of bias, given their membership of the Neighbourhood Development Plan Steering Group.

2.01 OPEN SESSION

During the Open Session, which was extended to 30 minutes with the consent of the Council:

- Mr A R R McAslan of Tokers Green Lane, Kidmore End, Ms S Wilkinson of Butlers Orchard, Kidmore End and Ms S Roe of Tokers Green Lane, Kidmore End, speaking on behalf of "Keep Kidmore End Green" (KKEG), urged the Council not to submit the Kidmore End Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) as presently drafted to the District Council, for a variety of reasons;
- Ms A Vorster of The Hamlet, Gallowstree Common and Ms S M Biggs of Tokers Green Lane, Kidmore End, speaking on behalf of the NDP Steering Group, asked the Council to submit the Plan, and sought to address some of the points made by the KKEG speakers;
- Dr C D Aldridge of Chalkhouse Green Road, Kidmore End spoke in support of the NDP.

2.02 KIDMORE END NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Mr J M Ducker moved the following motion:

"That the Parish Council submit the Kidmore End Neighbourhood Development Plan to South Oxfordshire District Council, in accordance with Regulation 15 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012".

Members discussed some of the points made during the Open Session.

The Chairman put the motion to the vote. There voted for the motion 4, and against 0. The motion was declared carried, unanimously.

RESOLVED: That the Kidmore End Neighbourhood Development Plan, as presented, be submitted to the District Council, in accordance with Regulation 15 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.
