

## OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

1. (KIDMORE END AND MAPLEDURHAM) (SPEED LIMITS) (No.\*) ORDER 20\*\*
2. (SONNING COMMON) (SPEED LIMITS) (No.\*) ORDER 20\*\*

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the orders - in support of road safety issues - is to introduce additional **20mph speed limits** throughout Kidmore End replacing the majority of the existing 30mph speed in the process as follows:

### A. Cane End:

1. Horsepond Road – to a point 350 metres northeast of its junction with the A4074 Reading Road,
2. Park Lane – to a point 450 metres north of its junction with Horsepond Road,
3. The Unnamed-road from the A4074 Reading Road – for its entire length.

### B. Chalkhouse Green:

4. Chalkhouse Green Road – to a point 330 metres west & northwards of its junction with Kidmore End Road,
5. Chalkhouse Green Lane – to a point 560 metres north-east & eastwards of its junction with Kidmore End Road,
6. Kidmore End Road – to a point 145 metres south of its junction with Chalkhouse Green Road/Lane,
7. Tanners Lane – for its entire length.

### C. Gallowstree Common:

8. Hazlemoor Lane – to a point 235 metres southeast of its junction with Horsepond Road,
9. Horsepond Road – between a point 165 metres southwest of its junction with Wood Lane & a point 22 metres northeast of its junction with Woodside Lane,
10. Orchard Field – for its entire length,
11. Reade's Lane – to a point 125 metres southeast of its junction with Horsepond Road,
12. The Hamlet – for its entire length,
13. Wyfold Road – to a point 460 metres north of its junction with Horsepond Road,
14. Wood Lane – to a point 360 metres southeast of its junction with Horsepond Road.

Sections of existing 30mph speed limit will remain in place on Hazlemoor Lane, Reades Lane (within the parish of Sonning Common) & Wood Lane as buffer limits, with Officers having taken the current road environment & traffic usage into account.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Kidmore End and Mapledurham) (Speed Limits) Order 2023, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Sonning Common) (Speed Limits) Order 2023 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.
